SEATTLE'S HIGH SEASON FOR SAVINGS RETURNS

Super Hotel Deals and Visitor Value Offers Promote Off-Season Travel

Beginning November 1, the Seattle Super Saver hotel booking program, operated year-around by Seattle's Convention and Visitors Bureau (SCVB), will provide patrons a complimentary value guide upon check-in that features more than 50 value offers that range from percentile discounts to two-for-one deals.
