CRUISE TERMINAL TRANSFER INFORMATION

- **Option 1:** Seattle Express offers one-way transport at \$12 per passenger to either cruise terminal. (Includes Airport area, Southside, and Downtown hotels). Reservations or inquiries made online. www.seattleexpress.com
- **Option 2:** Cruisers may take advantage of a pre-cruise tour with Seattle Tours, which also includes the added benefit of a complete tour of the city as luggage is forwarded directly to the departure terminal. Adults \$59, children \$46 tax included. (Seattle, Airport, Southside, Bellevue and Redmond hotels). www.seattlecitytours.com | 206.768.1234
- **Option 3:** Gray Line has a shuttle service called *Cruise Express*. *Cruise Express* is a direct transfer from the airport to Smith Cove Cruise Terminal at Pier 91 ONLY. Cruisers would need to first return to the Airport via their hotel airport shuttle and then pick up the *Cruise Express* at the Gray Line service desk located at the south end of baggage claim, at door 00 just past carousel 1. The cost is \$25.00 per adult passenger one way, \$40 roundtrip, \$12.50 per child passenger one way, \$20 roundtrip. ***Cruise Express* only services Holland America and Princess Cruise Lines.** For transfer information for Royal Caribbean, Norwegian and Celebrity Cruise Lines, please contact these companies directly. www.graylineseattle.com/cruiseexpress1.cfm | 800.426.7532
- **Option 4:** Shuttle Express offers transportation to/from either cruise terminal. Pick-up and drop-off locations include any greater Seattle area hotel, cruise terminals, or other select popular destinations. Visit www.shuttleexpress.com for a complete list of departure/arrival locations or to receive a rate quote.
- **Option 5:** There are numerous limousine and town car services that offer transport to the cruise terminals. Costs will vary.
- **Option 6:** Cruisers can make use of a taxicab services. Costs vary depending on departure location, but most fares from the airport to downtown run approximately \$35-\$40. Most fares from downtown hotels to the cruise

terminals run approximately \$10 - \$25, depending on the proximity of the hotel to the waterfront, and time of day.

- **Option 7:** Scenic Seattle Tours by Customized Tours provides chauffeured service to either cruise terminal from all downtown Seattle and SeaTac area hotels. Luggage space is limited, groups of 21 or more may need a separate luggage van. www.toursofseattle.com | 800.770.8769
- **Option 8:** Cruisers may also set up a pre-arranged transport package with their cruise line.
